for campers finishing kindergarten through 6th grade

Session One, Friends

June 27-July 1

Leadership Adventure camps are day programs

specifically designed for 6th-8th graders, ten days long and full of great fun and learning experiences. Campers enrolled in the Leadership Adventure program will have the opportunity to enjoy the fun of traditional Camp Wright Day Camp programming while developing leadership skills and teambuilding. Each morning will be spent enjoying all Camp Wright has to offer, kayaking and sailing on the bay, sports, swimming, arts and crafts and more. Afternoons will be spent developing teamwork and leadership skills through fun games and collaboration with our camp staff. This program is a great step on the journey to being a counselor in training and staff member. A special offsite trip will celebrate our journey as leaders and culminate each two week session. Leadership Adventure sessions run from 9am-4pm, Monday through Friday.

Health and Safety

Camp Wright is ACA accredited, inspected and licensed by the State of Maryland as a summer camp. Supervision for the day camp will be by counselors 18 years and older with younger assistants. Each adult counselor will be responsible for a group of 6-10 campers. Swimming, canoeing, and archery classes will all be led by certified lifeguards and instructors. Life preservers are worn at all times when boating. The Day Camp Program Director and camp counselors are certified in first aid and CPR. A Nurse is available when overnight camp is in session to assist in first aid. Camp Wright has standing orders from a local physician for our health plan. Each camper is required to submit a completed health history form.
