

Please read with care. This page contains important information to complete your camper's registration.

Camp Forms must be received 3 weeks prior to the start of your session. Please mail early:

- 2012 Health Form and Physical Exam Record, including front and back copies of insurance cards or equivalent
- Pick-up, Release, Terms of Registration Form
- Medication Orders for any kind of medications or treatment while at camp
- Balance due

A late fee of \$25 per form and balance will be charged if these items are not received. Cancellation of registration begins 10 days prior to session if forms and balance are not received.

Camper Health History Form 1 for Overnight Sessions (green)

- This form must be filled out annually with current health information and a current parent/guardian signature for permission to treat and emergency release
- Campers receiving medications or treatment at camp need to provide current information on page 2 and provide 2012 written orders from your physician for our health staff.
- Immunization History: Please provide immunization information on page 2. Previous campers may use 2011 records if requested in writing at least 3 weeks prior to session. Please update with the date of the child's most recent tetanus vaccination. Contact the office if immunizations are not done due to medical or religious reasons. TB test is not required.

Camper Health History Form 2 (pink)

- This form for your physician's office to complete and sign. Campers are required to have a physical within **12 months** of the start of camp. This is a change for 2012.
- Medications must be in the original containers and have the campers name and prescription information listed. Over-the-counter medications must also be sent in original containers. Camp Wright has standing orders and medications available for common problems such as headaches or stomach upset as listed on the green and pink health forms.

Pick-up, Release and Terms of Registration Form

- A signature is required at the bottom of this form by the parent or guardian.
- Campers attending an adventure session or Senior High Leadership will also have a release form from off-site vendors.
