- I understand the registration fee is a non-refundable processing fee after May 31st, unless the session is cancelled by Camp Wright or is full at the time of registration. I understand the session fee balance, for each camp session, is due 3 weeks prior to the start of the camp session.
- I understand that refunds or adjustments are granted at the sole discretion of Camp Wright.
- I understand that failure to appear at camp on opening day without prior notice forfeits the camp fee.
- Day Camp hours are from 9 AM-4 PM unless otherwise noted. I understand that an additional fee will be assessed if I drop off my camper earlier than 8:45 AM or pick up later than 4:00 PM.
- I understand that Camp Wright may close in the event of extreme weather events, including excessive heat warnings issued by state, county or local governments
- I understand that I will be required to pay a fee from \$30.00 up to the maximum allowed under Maryland law for any check returned or refused for processing by my bank. Camp Wright will process unpaid balances through the Queen Anne's County court system.

*Boating classes are conducted on public waters in front of our property and at a public landing on Great Neck Rd. All activities are under the supervision of trained instructors and lifeguards. Occasionally, staff may plan off site trips These and any other trips are supervised by adult staff and follow Maryland Health Department and American Camp Association standards and guidelines.

Camp Wright is a ministry of the Episcopal Diocese of Easton. Campers of all faiths are welcome and accepted into our program. Attendance at worship and Christian Education activities is expected of all campers. We encourage all participants to love themselves, others and God, and to treat all people with dignity and respect. We seek to model our behavior after Christ and follow the camp motto, "Learning to live together in a Christian way."

- ◆ Camp Wright reserves the right to refuse to accept any camper whose parent or guardian's behavior is a detriment to the camp or unprofessional to any of our participants.
- ◆ Camp Wright reserves the right to refuse to accept, or to send home, any camper whose behavior is unmanageable, a detriment to the camp program or endangers campers or staff.
- ◆ Campers and their parents or guardians are responsible for damage done to Camp property and the personal belongings of others if this damage is a result of abuse or negligence on the part of the camper.
- ◆ Camp Wright does not permit weapons, illegal or controlled substances at camp. Possession of these items is grounds for immediate dismissal from the program and notification of the proper law enforcement agency.
- ◆ Camp activities and programs are supervised by adult leaders and instructors. Campers are expected to listen to and follow all safety rules and procedures, and to obey camp guidelines and rules as presented at camp.
