

Counselors in Training have been an important part of the Camp Wright Resident Camp community for

more than 20 years. The CIT position is an exciting and fun opportunity to experience camp in a whole new way. CIT participants will grow in professional skills: leadership, communication and problem solving while living in community and exploring the staff side of the Camp Wright experience. Each CIT session can be used for 70 hours of community service or student service learning.

- Campers who have completed 10th grade are eligible to apply to be CITs. Campers who have completed 9th grade are encouraged to attend Senior High Leadership and Senior Camp.
- CITs will register as campers using our <u>registration portal</u> with their Parent/Guardian's account. Choose CIT Sessions, and make sure you have listed a valid email address for the CIT Candidate.
- All CITs will be contacted to complete a phone interview with our Program Director. Look for an email from office@campwright.com.
- CITs will be assigned to 2 sessions of service over the course of the summer.
- During their sessions, the CIT will work with a cabin and a staff member on a program schedule. Our CIT coordinators will plan evenings of community time with CITs in each session to discuss their experience, reflect on their roles at Camp Wright.
- CITs are required to attend a training session at Camp Wright, in June. Details will be provided soon.
- All CIT applications are due by May 1 and CIT assignments will be sent out by May 15.
- Unfortunately, the number of CIT candidates is much greater than the number of CIT
- positions. CITs will be chosen based on experience, availability, and previous performance. Please do not be discouraged if you are not accepted to the program this summer; be persistent, develop your skills, and apply again next summer.
