



Camp Wright Counselor in Training Information

Counselors in Training have been an important part of the Camp Wright community for more than 20 years. The CIT position is an exciting and fun opportunity to experience camp in a whole new way. It's hard work, but a great time!

CIT applicants will apply at <https://campwright.campintouch.com/v2/login/login.aspx> CITs will register as campers in their parent/guardian account but when choosing their session, choose the CIT Sessions. All CITs will need to complete a phone interview with the Associate Director after their application has been processed. The Associate Director will email the CITs to set up the phone interview. Please make sure a valid email address for the CIT is included in the application.

CITs will be assigned to 2 sessions of service over the course of the summer. During their sessions, the CIT will work with a cabin and a staff member on a program schedule. CITs will also help our kitchen staff to serve meals and clean up in the dining hall as needed to supplement their program responsibilities.. Our CIT coordinators will plan evenings of community time with CITs in each session to discuss their experience, reflect on their roles at Camp Wright, and have some fun!

- All CIT applications are due by May 1 and CIT assignments will be sent out by June 1.
- CIT applicants should list at least three sessions which they will be available so we can assign sessions appropriately.
- Arrival: CITs should arrive after 7pm the evening before their session begins.
- Departure: CITs will be finished with their service at approximately 12 pm on the day their session ends and should be picked up promptly.
- CITs who have their licenses are permitted to drive themselves to and from camp, but should not use their vehicles during session without the written permission of their parents or guardians.
- Each CIT session can be used for 70 hours of community service or student service learning requirements. We will be happy to verify your service with a letter at the end of the summer and any additional forms that may be required as requested.
- CIT training will take place virtually. This training is required for new CIT participants. Dates will follow in an email after the application has been processed.

Unfortunately, the number of CIT candidates is much greater than the number of CIT positions. CITs will be chosen based on experience, age, availability, and previous performance, where applicable. Please do not be discouraged if you are not accepted to the program this summer; be persistent, develop your skills and apply again next summer.
