

# Day Camp What to Bring

## **LABEL EVERY INDIVIDUAL THING!**

Come dressed in a **swimming suit** with **sunscreen already applied** under camp clothes (*comfortable clothes that can get dirty*) for easier transitions in the morning.

### **Bring:**

- ◇ **Backpack**- to carry items during the day
- ◇ **Change of clothes**-in your backpack
- ◇ **Pool Towel**
- ◇ **Sunscreen**- please apply sunscreen BEFORE arriving at camp. Counselors will remind campers to re-apply but they will not apply sunscreen to your child
- ◇ **Water Bottle**- a reusable bottle that they can refill throughout the day
- ◇ **Packed Lunch**- lunches are kept in refrigerators until they are distributed
- ◇ **Closed-toe shoes**
- ◇ **Flip flops or sandals**-for pool
- ◇ **Water shoes**

**Prescribed medications** (if any)- Must be in ***original packaging*** along with ***written directions from the doctor*** for administration

If a camper forgets or loses an item, our staff will find a suitable replacement to ensure all campers are prepared for activities. If necessary our staff will call home to replace certain items

### **WHAT NOT TO BRING**

- **NUT products**- of any kind or any products that are processed in a facility with nuts.
- **Gum**
- **Pets**
- **Tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs or other controlled substances**
- **Weapons of any kind or fireworks**
- **iPods, tablets, or other electronic devices**
- **Cash**
- **CELL PHONES**- are disruptive to our program and do not encourage campers to reach out to staff members when they have specific needs. Cell phones brought to camp will be confiscated and stored until pick up; parental support of this policy is expected and appreciated.

Camp Wright is not responsible for lost, stolen or otherwise damaged items that are brought to camp. Lost and found items are collected and displayed each day during camp. Camp Wright will make every attempt to return lost items to campers after their camp session. Camper families are responsible for any postage and handling costs if items are mailed. Items left at camp after Labor Day will be donated to local charities.
